February 02, 2014 Membership Meeting Minutes

Indiana Dairy Goat Assoc. met on Feb 2, 2014 at Farm Bureau offices in Indianapolis. Meeting was called to order by President Tim VanZant at 2:18 p.m. Roll call was answered by President Tim VanZant, Secretary Bonnie Robbins, Treasurer Marianne Ingle and directors Diana Hubbard, David Ingle, David Spear, Jerry Lubbehusen, Patty Baker and Joan Wheatly. December minutes were read and approved. Treasurer report was presented and approved. Marianne will handle re-investment of the CD which matures end of February.

Patty presented information on the Hoosier Classic. The fairground had double booked the weekend of June 7-8 and subsequently moved the Hoosier Classic to June 14-15. Contract has been received back from Will Pearson-second contract has been sent and that judge will be made public when contract is received. Discussion was held about offering a separately sanctioned 2 ring buck show on Friday night, for a total of 4 buck rings during the weekend. Tim will work on finding two local judges for this and if they can be secured, we will apply for the sanctioning for this show. Wether show will be held first thing on Saturday. Discussion was held regarding trophies and photographer. Patty will contact a local photographer regarding their availability. It was decided that this year we will do trophies (duffle bags) for Best In Show winners, Showmanship winners (expect the little ones who will still get trophies), most shown and farthest traveled and pails for best udder winners. No trophies will be given this year for breed winners, but the club will pay for breed winners (Champions) to have pictures taken.

Teena announced that state fair judge has been secured. There will be a new computer program for this year and all 4H entries will have to be done on line. Exhibitors can come in late Tuesday or early Wednesday. She is looking for a secretary for the open ring show.

Discussion was held about finding someone to chair the Youth committee. Youth rep selection will be done at our April meeting.

Tim asked for suggestions regarding fall conference for this year. It was decided we would try to have it at the same location. One suggestion was to have presentation on goat milk soap/lotion. It was decided to take the profit from the past conference and divide it three ways between the club and the two presenters, who had given of their time and supplies at no charge to our club.

Show packets will be assembled at the April meeting. Show chairs need to get 50 copies of their show bill, an electronic copy of the show bill and \$15 to Marianne before the April meeting.

Teena announced Easter kid pickup will likely be early April.

After all business was completed, election of officers was held. Juli Huffman had notified that due to her new work duties she would not be running for any offices. Our new officers/directors are as follows:
