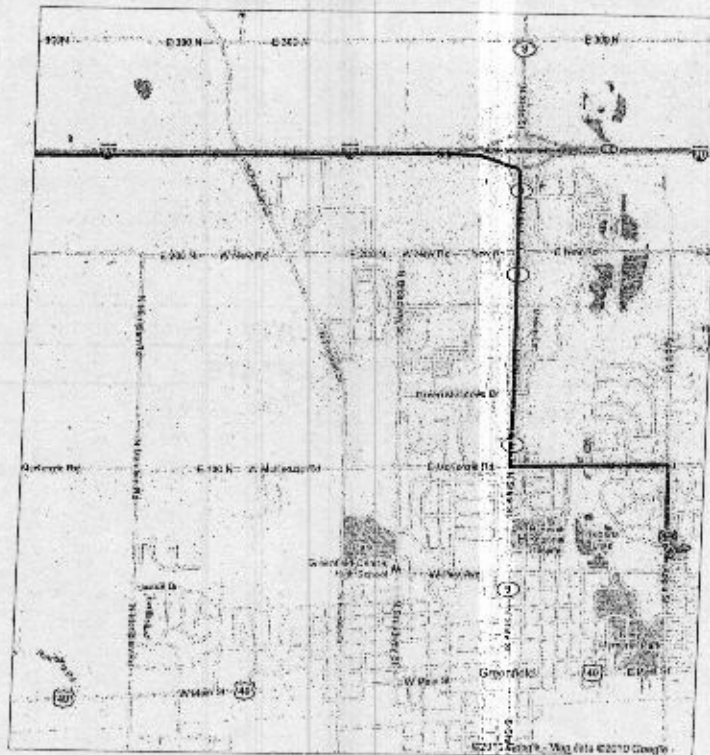


**Directions to Hancock Co. Extension Office**

Head East toward E Market St	go 0.1 mi	total 0.1 mi
Exit the traffic circle onto N Meridian St	go 302 ft	total 0.2 mi
Turn right at E Ohio St. (about 3 mins )	go 0.8 mi	total 1.0 mi
Continue onto N pine St (about 1 min)	go 0.3 mi	total 1.3 mi
Keep right at the fork, follow signs for I-70 E from Indianapolis (about 23 mins)	go 20.9 mi	total 22.2 mi
Take exit 104 for IN-9 toward Maxwell/Greenfield	go 0.4 mi	total 22.6 mi
Turn right at IN-9 S/N State St (about 3 mins)	go 1.4 mi	total 24.0 mi
Turn left at E McKenzie Rd (about 2 mins)	go 0.7 mi	total 24.7 mi
Turn right at Apple St (Destination will be on the right) (about 1 min)	go 0.5 mi	total 25.2 mi

The Indiana Dairy Goat Association met on Sunday, January 9, 2011 at the Hancock Co. Extension Office. President Jerry Lubbehusen called the meeting to order at 2:30 p.m. Officers present were President Jerry Lubbehusen, Secretary Bonnie Robbins, and Treasurer Marianne Ingle. Directors present were Chris Hudson, Sue Schroeder, Patty Baker, David Ingle and David Spear. State Fair rep Teena Spear was also present. December minutes were presented and accepted as presented. Marianne gave the treasurer's report and Sue gave the newsletter report.

Rob was not present but sent word that judge contracts for the Hoosier Classic have been sent and we are awaiting their return. There will be no bucks shown and Nigerian dwarfs and Sables will be put in an AOP class. Lawrence Co. show is set for May 8 in Bedford; Richmond show will be June 25-26 for Dairy, June 19 for meat goats. AGS National Show is the same weekend as the Hoosier Classic and will be held in Northern Indiana. ADGA registered animals are eligible to be shown at the AGS show.

Youth rep presentations and voting will be held at the March meeting. There was discussion that one interested youth had a legitimate conflict with the date. It was voted to allow any youth who have legitimate conflicts with the March meeting date to submit their presentations via video to be shown at the March meeting. Those youth need to contact Chris Hudson and have their video and scrapbook to Chris before the March meeting.

Teena gave the State Fair report. 4-H judges for all species will be unpublished until the day of the show. Nigerian dwarfs can be used for showmanship in the 4H competition. If anyone has any ideas that would aid in the 4H check in, pass those ideas on to Teena. Ring size is still being discussed. Trophy sponsors need to get their payments to Marianne as soon as possible.

Teena also advised that Easter kid pick up will likely be mid-April as Easter is late this year. Persons with kids should contact Teena in early April. Ideal weight is 20-50#. Teena also mentioned there may be a future export opportunity as well.

Chris advised that Megan Tucker is still working on getting an email notification set up- she is weeding out incorrect and duplicate emails.

Next meeting will be February 6, 2011 at Hancock Co. Meeting was adjourned at 3:00 p.m.

The Indiana Dairy Goat Association will be compiling it's 2011 show packet at the April 3<sup>rd</sup> meeting. If you want your show bill included in this packet, there are several steps you must take:

1. Make 250 copies of your show bill.
2. Staple the pages together. Do not fold the show bills.
3. There is a charge of \$15.00 per show, to help cover the postage.
4. The check must accompany the show bills. If the show bills arrive with no check, SORRY, the bills will be left out.
5. Mail to the above address by March 25<sup>th</sup>. I need all show bills in my hands by this date. The packets will be put together before the meeting.
6. If you are interested in placing an ad in the show packet, the price would be \$15.00 for a full page ad. Again you would need to send me 250 copies. This packet is mailed to all of the IDGA members plus 14 other states. This is a very cheap way to advertise your show. The packets will be mailed on Tuesday after the Sunday meeting.

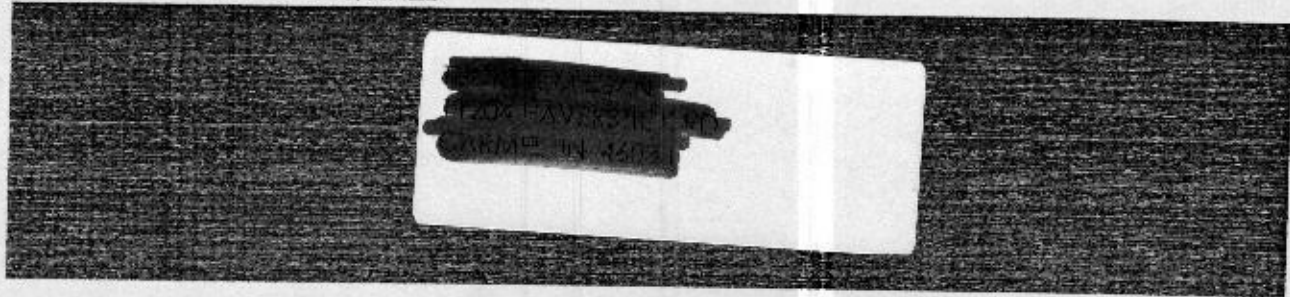
