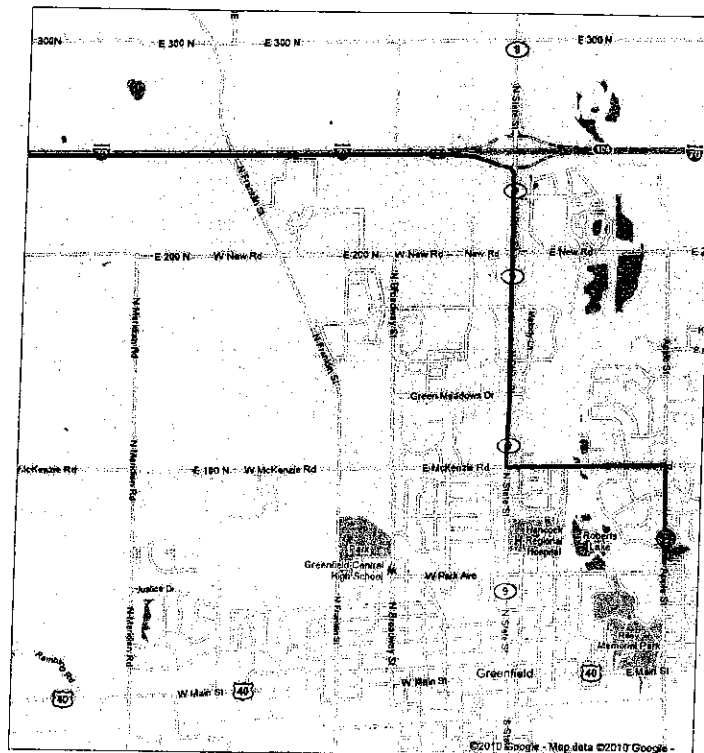

The Indiana Dairy Goat Association met on Saturday, November 6, 2010 at the North American Livestock Expo in Louisville. President Jerry Lubbehusen called the meeting to order at 12:00 noon. Due to the fact there was not a member quorum at the October meeting, officer and director elections were conducted. President Jerry Lubbehusen was re-elected as was secretary Bonnie Robbins. Marianne Ingle will serve as treasurer. New directors are David Spear, Patty Baker and David Ingle. Chris Hudson will chair the youth committee. Jerry expressed gratitude to Terry Jaenichen and her family for their past service on the youth committee.

Rob reported on the Hoosier Classic. He has a contract out to one judge and calls to others to secure the second judge. Discussion was held about sanctioning of Nigerian Dwarfs and Sables and possible use of AOP. This will be looked into further. Rob again advised that this would be his last year as chair of the Hoosier Classic and that he felt it would be a good idea to have a committee for the show who can bring in new ideas. It has been very difficult to get raffle kids donated, auction prices on the kids have been very low the last few years. Any new ideas for the show are most welcome.

Teena announced that the 2011 State Fair goat show will be held in the swine barn-dates are unknown yet. She has made some recommendations for class revisions and the show schedule is being reviewed to try to make it possible to get the show over earlier on Sunday. The milk test will be ADGA official, however, participants MUST be pre-registered for the milk test.

Meeting dates for 2011 were announced, as follows: Jan. 9, Feb. 6, Mar 6, April 3, Oct. 2, Nov. 5 and Dec. 4. The April meeting will be at Burnettsville, the November meeting at NAILE in Louisville. All other meetings will be held at the Hancock County Extension office in Greenfield. Chris Hudson was able to secure this meeting place for us at no charge. Additionally, if necessary we can use a meeting room at the state fairgrounds.

Youth rep presentations will be done in March with the entire membership present at the meeting voting on the representatives. The announcement of the youth rep & runner up will be the Saturday morning of the Hoosier Classic.

Mike Summerlot shared some information about town hall meetings held for goat & sheep producers. Information is being gathered for the purpose of applying for a grant that will look into setting up markets for sheep and goats. Show dates should be gotten to Sue as soon as possible so they can be printed in the newsletter. Greenfield show will be May 21, June 11-12 will be the Hoosier Classic and June 18 is the Elnora Show. A representative from the Boone County Goat Association advised about some changes they are working on and that there will be a show and production sale in Spring 2011 and a show in the fall of 2011. More information will follow.

Reminder that dues need to be paid to Marianne Ingle by the end of December. Jerry dismissed the meeting at 12:55 p.m.

An executive board meeting was held following the membership meeting.
